## **Educational Visits to Hasty's (Available April – October)**

£7.50 per child\* which includes:

- 30 minute animal feed guided by a Hasty's team member,
- Worksheets and visit guidance provided by Hasty's,
- Access to the farm for the whole day,

This is our standard education package, there is a Hasty's-led animal feed and then the groups are led by teachers and adults from their school, with educational boards and signage around the farm to help guide them with their worksheets.

Pre-visit guidance for adults and children, as well as a master copy of the worksheet for the adults will also be provided.

For an extra £1.00 per child, a workshop can be added onto the visit. This is led by a member of the Hasty's team and can cover a variety of topics and ages. If a workshop is chosen, an itinerary will be sent across to ensure you get the most from your time at the farm. A full overview of the workshops provided are laid out below.
